

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION FROM SALT LAKE

The Saltlec complex is part of the Salt lake area of the city, a huge 12,000 sq. km residential hub with over 4-6 lakh residents. Units in Saltlec are about 20-25 minutes from Park Street (central Kolkata) on one side and the airport on the other. Residential areas in South Kolkata such as Gariahat are also about 30 minutes away. 12 bus routes operate to Salt Lake during office hours, with the number coming down to 5 for the rest of the day. The Saltlec units are accessible by auto-rickshaws to the EM Bypass, and taxis are easily available during normal office hours. The Bidhannagar Railway Station, located less than 15 minutes away, provides links to the city's suburban rail networks. Kolkata also has the country's only underground train network – Belgachia and Park Street are the nearest metro stations from Salt Lake (Attached map details the distance of Salt Lake area from different part of Kolkata)

To further strengthen the location transportations, the Government of West Bengal along with Webel has taken the following short-term and long-term measures:

- Increase buses, auto rickshaws, shared cabs within Salt Lake city (2-3 months)
- Increase bus routes from Salt Lake city to important junctions in the city (2-3 months)
- Provide “call a cab” service to IT industry professionals (already commissioned)
- Extend the Metro to Salt Lake Area (End of 2005)
